THE515 Theatre for Social Change

This capstone course is one that should let BA/BS Theatre students create an original piece based on their experiences of community interactions that need to change. This could mean interviewing subjects within the MSU community itself or other larger community settings. For example, their current project topic is The Abuse of Power. Their final performance of this piece occurs on the final day of classes and runs 60 minutes with 15 minutes left for talkback Q&A. Since other programs in the department use their final solo/duet performance productions as their PAIE, we are simply following protocol established by other programs in our department. Since we have now changed THE 323 to a Devised Theatre Performance course as the pre-requisite for THE 515, it follows that THE 515 should be the final devised performance production for the BA/BS programs.
