Position: OAEH Project Management Intern

Summary: This on-site internship at the O'Reilly Center for Hope is orientated around the Continuum of Care (CoC), Ozarks Alliance to End Homelessness (OAEH), for Springfield/Greene, Chrisitan, and Webster Counties.
